

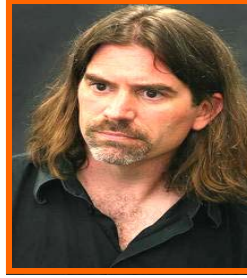
Meet our featured Storytellers for 2011...



Milbre Burch (MO)

Experience the fine art performances of this internationally known storyteller who will be making her third appearance in Mariposa. Also an award winning recording artist,

poet and writer, she shapes her compelling stories with an artful language of gesture and movement.



Peter Cook (IL)

Step into the world of internationally reputed Deaf performing artist, Peter Cook whose stories are a potpourri of American Sign Language, pantomime, storytelling, acting

and movement. Appealing to both Deaf and hearing communities, a voice interpreter will speak his signs for hearing audiences.

Sunny Dooley (NM)

Sunny, a Dine' or Navajo, storyteller, and playwright, from the Four Corners region, tells traditional stories from her matrilineal clan, the Saltwater People. She has appeared at festivals, schools and universities in the Southwest and at the Smithsonian's National Museum of the American Indian.



Gay Ducey (CA)

This master storyteller and librarian will tell you she is descended from Southern women who treasured a sassy mouth. She relishes the diverse and the novel, but reveres the traditional place of stories in family and community. However, she still can't resist stepping into any parade that passes by.



Baba Jamal Koram

(MN) Baba Jamal Koram's grandmother would say, "Bring me a cool glass of water and I'll tell you a story." Her grandson now carries on her Griotic Tradition bringing alive the

history, humor, people, music and lore of African-American and African cultures through Aesop's fables, stories and songs.

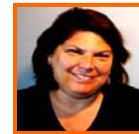


Jim May (IL)
